To access myAdelaide, you will need your AU student account number and must activate your account.

If you are a **UoA Foundation Studies student**, you can log into myAdelaide using your existing student ID and login credentials.

1. How to activate your Student Account Number




1. Open your email

Check your inbox for an email from Student_Transition@study.adelaideuni.edu.au.

This email includes your **Student Account Number** and a link to activate your account.

2. Click the activation link

In the email, scroll down and select the **Activate Your Account** button.



Individual AU number

Before you can start using your AU student account number to log into myAdelaide, you'll need to activate your account. This involves setting up your password and multi-factor authentication.

To get started, click the **Activate Your Account** button in this email. On the page that opens, select **Activate Account** and enter your AU Student Account Number (listed in this email). Click **Send** to receive a verification email, which will be sent to your personal email address currently on file with UniSA. Then, open the message from no-reply@okta.adelaide.edu.au and follow the instructions to complete your account activation.

3. Select 'Activate Account'


You will be taken to the account activation page. Click **Activate Account**.


4. Enter your Student Account Number

This will trigger an automatic email to be sent to your personal email address currently on file with UniSA








6. Activate your Okta Account

Open the new email from

Activate Okta Account button.


The link will expire in 7 days, so be sure to activate within this timeframe.





7. Set a password

8. Set up your multi-factor authentication

Select either Okta Verify (recommended) or Google Authenticator. Once setup is complete, you can sign in to Okta and access the <u>Adelaide University student portal</u>.
