The following Criteria is deemed essential for appointment as an Executive Partner:

- significant corporate or not for profit executive management experience
- experience is contemporary (within the last five years)
- experience in coaching and mentoring
- tertiary qualification(s) or equivalent experience
- experience with successful organisational culture development and implementation
- experience with Board involvement including reporting to directors/CEO/chair
- experience with international contexts within previous roles **Preferred**
- experience in starting or sustaining a profitable business Optional

While specific industry experience is highly regarded, it is not essential when an applicant can demonstrate the essential criteria.
