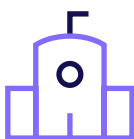

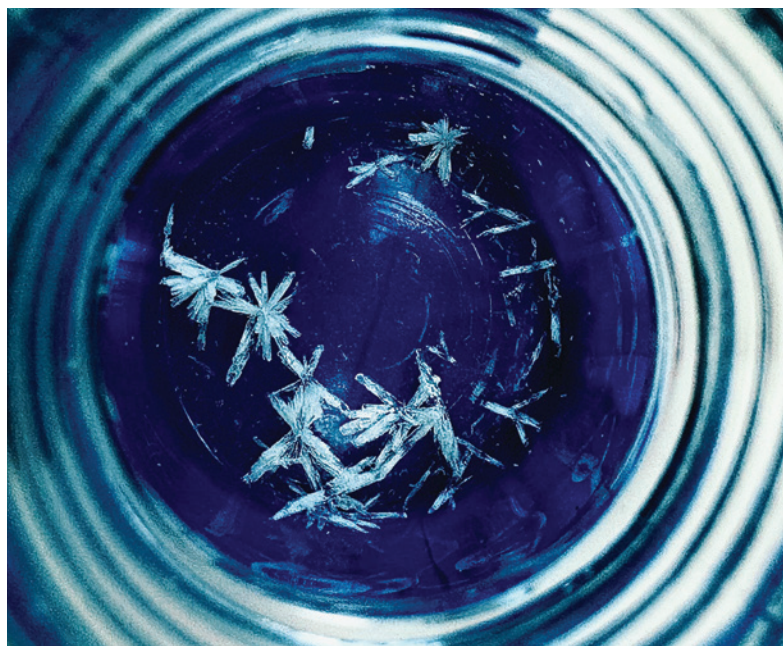
Personal & Societal Health
