Applicant to address the following (please adhere to the word limit and note that the Genuine Temporary Entrant requirement NO LONGER APPLIES):

1. Give details of your current circumstances. This includes ties to family, community, employment and economic circumstances (150 words).
2. Explain why you wish to study this program in Australia (rather than in your home country) and with Adelaide University in particular. This must also explain your understanding of the requirements of the intended program and studying and living in Australia (150 words).
3. Explain how completing the program will be of benefit to you (150 words).
4. Give details of any other relevant information you would like to include (150 words).
[if relevant] Along with any other information you wish to include, briefly mention any onshore relatives that you have, what role they played in influencing your decision to study at Adelaide University and the support that they will be providing you (if any) during your studies.
5. [if relevant] Provide a detailed history of your study record in Australia from the date of first arrival.

- Please attach supporting documents (if you haven't already) to demonstrate how you meet the Genuine Student Requirement.
