Attachment 7 - Under 18 checklist (intention of parents)

All citizenships

To assist you with your Adelaide University and student visa application, please address the following Checklist:

- **A separate statement from the parents (in addition to the responses from the applicant). This should address the GSR criteria, in particular:**
 - Family, community, employment, and economic circumstances
 - Why they think the applicant should study the proposed program/s (rather than in their home country), and with Adelaide University in particular
 - Their understanding of the requirements of the program/s
 - Their understanding of the proposed provider and why they chose them (in comparison to other providers)
 - Their understanding of studying and living in Australia (including where the applicant plans to live and why)
 - Their understanding of the costs associated with living in Australia and studying the proposed program/s
 - How completing the program/s will be of benefit to the applicant.
- **Evidence to substantiate the parents' claims, including:**
 - Evidence of their research – including research of other study providers (in their home country, other destinations, and Australia, with a conclusion as to why they ultimately chose Adelaide University).
 - Evidence of future employment opportunities as a result of the applicant completing the proposed program/s. Include specific roles they would be qualified for as a result of undertaking the program/s.
- **Any other information the parents would like to include (more information is best)**
- **Evidence of genuine access to funds equal to at least one year of tuition, living, and travel expenses for the applicant, including:**

- Evidence as to the source of funds - how were they accumulated? Provide e.g., sale documents/employment contracts together with salary slips, bank statements showing transactional evidence/salary being deposited (1 year), and income tax documents (3 years)
- Evidence and information as to the family's personal and financial circumstances (and those of the sponsor, if different). Provide e.g., sale documents /savings over time (provide bank deposit/transactional trail)
- **Parents and applicant MUST be prepared for any interview with the Department of Home Affairs as to the application, and in particular, the above.**
