### **Biography**

Born in 1912, Rolfe Vernon Boehm was educated at Goodwood, the SA School of Mines and Industries and the University of Adelaide. He was articled to architect F.W. Hocart and was the Works Manager for Wunderlich Ltd from 1934-1938. He was an Associate to F. Kenneth Milne from 1938 for four years. After active service in World War Two, he became a partner in Milne's firm in 1946. In 1956 he designed the Metro Drive-in Theatre at Marion (Morphettville) and established a branch office for the firm at Whyalla in 1959, working there until 1963. He was active in the SA Chapter of the RAIA and served as President in 1962-64. In 1971 he established a branch office for his firm in Darwin and worked there until 1977. In 1978 he was Marketing Manager for Civil and Civic Pty Ltd, Darwin. He died at Victor Harbor in 1999.

#### **Collection description**

The Rolfe Boehm collection comprises a curriculum vitae for Rolfe Boehm which details his architectural career, slides and photographs of buildings including those he worked on as an architect and a scrapbook which includes newspaper clippings and ephemera.
