BIOGRAPHY

Albert Gillissen, architect and academic, was born in Vlissingen, Netherlands on 7 September 1921. He graduated with Honours in Architecture and Town Planning from the University of Auckland in 1958. He held positions of Senior Lecturer, Acting Dean and Dean in the Faculty of Architecture at the University of Adelaide from 1963 to 1986 and was a member of the RAIA, ANZIA, ARIBA, MRAPI and MNZPI. He retired from academic life in 1986 and was made a Life Fellow of the RAIA SA Chapter in 2001. Albert Gillissen passed away on 16 November 2016.

Gillissen grew up in Middelburg, Netherlands. During World War Two he was a member of the resistance movement and in 1944-1946 worked as an interpreter for the Allied units in Europe. In October 1946, he moved to Indonesia where he was employed as an immigration officer. In 1950 he joined the Dutch Merchant Navy and in 1952 emigrated to New Zealand where he found work as a milking hand on a dairy farm, among other jobs. He enrolled to study architecture aged 31, working in architects' offices while studying. Gillissen received numerous grants and awards, including the University Prize for Excellence in Architecture (1956), an Honours Grant (1957), the NZ Universities' Travelling Scholarship in Architecture (1959) and a Dutch government study grant.

In 1959 Gillissen worked in London in the architectural design section of Ove Arup & Partners, and in 1960 he took up the Travelling Scholarship. After further studies and research in European architecture he returned to Auckland where he worked in architectural offices and tutored at the University. In 1962 he was awarded a Postgraduate Diploma in Town Planning. He was appointed Senior Lecturer in Architecture at the University of Adelaide in 1963. Gillissen and his wife Leentje (Lenny) Clement had a daughter. They later divorced and his second partner was Helena Bakker.

He was a prolific writer, speaker and contributor at conferences, in journals and for committees. Gillissen's architectural commissions included a feasibility study and master plan for accommodation on a 32-hectare site owned by the Lutheran Church at McLaren Vale as well as designs for a housing complex for the Kent Town Homes for the Aged. Study leave from the university in 1969 was taken in field research in North and South American, Japan, USSR and Europe. Study leave in 1977 included a period as Visiting Professor at the Universiti Sains Malaysia. During 1981-82 he was Visiting Fellow at the National University of Singapore.

He was a foundation member of the committee establishing the University of the Third Age (U3A) in South Australia and lectured in various groups from 1987 to 2006. From the 1980s Gillissen was involved with the revival of the home silk weaving industry in Isan, north-east Thailand and with planning, development and design of work studios and associated structures and housing, on a voluntary basis. He designed his own eco-friendly timber house in Aldinga Beach where he and Helena lived from 1991 to 2007.
