HALL, Robert SERIES 470

BIOGRAPHY

Architect Robert Hall was a partner in the practice of Woodhead Hall McDonald Shaw.

The practice had its start when, in 1927 sole practitioner Edward Caradoc Ashton began work as an architect. Robert Woodhead became an articled pupil of Caradoc Ashton in 1932. Since 1933 the practice had an ongoing client in the Royal Agricultural and Horticultural Society of South Australia at the Wayville Showgrounds. Caradoc Ashton joined with Norman C. Fisher to form the partnership of Ashton and Fisher in 1935 gaining their first major commission of reconstructing the Gepps Cross Abattoirs in 1936.

The practice became Caradoc Ashton, Fisher, Woodhead and Beaumont Smith and produced such buildings as the Savings Bank of South Australia Building in Hindley Street, Adelaide (1957), the Electricity Trust of South Australia head office at Eastwood (1964) and the Chrysler automobile plant, Tonsley Park (1965).

In 1973 new partners saw the practice renames as Woodhead Hall McDonald Shaw and it designed the multi-storey Education Building on Flinders Street, Adelaide (1976). Through a series of mergers the firm expanded in the 1980s and established offices in Asia and the Middle-East during the 1990s when it was renamed Woodhead Firth Lee.

Since becoming known as Woodhead, the practice worked across a variety of building and development projects and expanded to have offices across Australia and Asia. In April 2014 parts of the company merged with global engineering practice, GHD and following this, Woodhead went into receivership.
