BIOGRAPHY

Laurence Schneider was born in 1937? and attended the University of Adelaide in the late 1950s. He was a talented artist and a qualified architect. He was active in student affairs, drawing cartons and caricatures for the University student newspaper On Dit. He formed an art group, organised art exhibitions, wrote articles and contributed artwork to the student magazines Spectrum, which he established, and Fabric, which he edited. Laurence Schneider died in 1987, aged 50.

COLLECTION DESCRIPTION

The Schneider collection comprises published caricatures (newspaper clippings), copies of magazine issues of Spectrum and Fabric and contributions to Spectrum issue 4 by Mary P Harris. Spectrum was published by the Rainbow Group, with issue 4 dated 1956 and including an article titled Art and Society by Laurence Schneider. Fabric was the magazine of the Adelaide University Architectural Society and includes commentary on architectural education and then-current building works. Fabric issue 1, July 1961, includes an article by Laurence Schneider titled Anarchy in Art, and issue 2, dated 1962, includes artwork by Laurence Schneider and also an article titled Build Your Own Ruin.
