**BIOGRAPHY**

Mervyn Ashmore Smith (11/12/1904–14/3/1994) was born in Sydney and lived much of his childhood with his maternal grandmother and aunts, who very likely encouraged him to develop his drawing and to pursue a career in architecture.

After two years at Newcastle High School, in about 1918 Smith began work as a clerk, taking evening classes in art at the Hamilton Technical College from 1921 to 1923; he won the prize for top student in 1921. From 1925 to 1929 he was apprenticed to Wm. D. Jeater in the architectural firm of Thomas J. Pepper & Jeater and in 1927 began night studies for an architectural diploma at the Newcastle branch of Sydney Technical College, graduating in 1933. From 1930 to 1934 he was employed by several firms as a draftsman, and from 1935 to 1938 as supervising architect for P.J. Gannon, New Lambton, NSW. He then returned to Sydney to work as an architect for the Department of Works and Local Government. He joined the Commonwealth Department of Works in 1941 and was sent to Adelaide; he married the artist Ruth Tuck in 1943.

Smith returned to Newcastle in 1949 as a town planner for the Northumberland County Council, qualifying as a town planner in 1952. In 1953 he returned to Adelaide as an architect for the Department of Works, where he remained until his retirement at the end of 1969.

His early architectural works include the nurses' home at the M.M. Hospital, Waratah and St Joseph's Church, Condobolin, both in NSW. When employed by the Department of Works and Local Government he was principally engaged on technical colleges, schools, hospitals and nurses' homes. In South Australia he designed post offices and telephone exchanges in suburban and rural areas and was project architect for the terminal buildings at Adelaide Airport. Unfortunately, because of government bureaucracy, he was seldom given the opportunity to fully implement his original designs, thus there are relatively few buildings that truly reflect his ideas.

In 1935 he gained a qualification with the Royal Sanitary Institute. He became an Associate of the Royal Australian Institute of Architects (RAIA) in 1938, Fellow in 1970. He qualified as an Associate of the Royal Association of British Architects in 1939 and, later, membership of the Royal Australian Planning Institute. The RAIA (SA Chapter) honoured the significance of his combination of architecture and art with an Award of Merit in 1984. In 1994 his contributions to Australia were belatedly recognised with an Order of Australia Medal.

After his retirement from architecture he devoted all his time to his art and was president of the Royal South Australian Society of Arts from 1967 to 1970. From his first exhibition in 1947 until 1993 his works were shown in numerous solo, joint and group exhibitions and he won many prizes for his watercolours and drawings. His works are part of many permanent public collections in Australia.

### **COLLECTION DESCRIPTION**

The Mervyn Smith collection is divided into the following series: Student work (Newcastle Technical College), primarily 1927-34; Apprenticeship, 1925-29, work with J.P. Gannon, 1935-3; work with the Department of Works and Local Government, Sydney, 1938-41; work with the Department of Works, Adelaide, 1941-49; Town-planning work, primarily Newcastle and district, 1949-52; work with the Department of Works, Adelaide, 1953-69; Private work, 1927-c.1960; and certificates, curriculum vitae, interviews, and drafting tools and accessories.

The more than 40 years of work includes many different categories of building, and several styles. Apart from the finished (printed) plans, there are also a large number of preliminary plans and sketches, not only from his private work, but also in particular from the Department of Works Adelaide, and from the town-planning. From these one can see Smith's own extensive design-work particularly in three large projects – the War-Service Homes, Adelaide (1947-48), the town planning in and near Newcastle (1949-52), and the Adelaide Airport terminal (1956-57).

Correspondence, specifications, and photographs are scattered unevenly through the overall collection. There are a few letters from Smith's private architectural work, while there are many relevant extracts from letters written to his wife during some of his town-planning in Newcastle. Many job-applications are also included. There is a large diary from 1938, which contains many details about Smith's work with P.J. Gannon, and extracts have been included from diaries of 1927 and 1928. Interviews (whole or part) with Smith have been included from 1964, 1980-81, and 1985. The photos include a few from student field-work, some professional photos taken in the town-planning office, and fine aerial photos taken for Smith's town-planning in 1949-51.

### **COLLECTION NOTE**

#### **The Condition of the Collection Prior to its Assembling**

In 2004 it was decided to gather together Smith's architectural and town-planning material. At that time, large portions of this collection were in considerable disorder, and stored in many different parts of Smith's house and shed. Consequently, the present organisation of the collection has been done by Smith's son Mark. Many of the preliminary plans and sketches (architectural and town-planning) were not identified – most of these have been identified by Mark Smith on a label, or in pencil small on a margin. Some of the original wrappings and folders were discarded because of their poor condition, or because their acidity was affecting the contents, but any writing on them was kept.

Smith's work as a student, with its associated material, forms a very comprehensive part of the collection, and possibly includes every notebook, and almost every plan, drawing and essay that was submitted for assessment. Among the textbooks are several that he won as prizes.

Although most of Smith's studies were at the Newcastle Technical College, it seems that possibly all of the architectural teaching there, and all of the assessments and exams were done by staff of the Sydney Technical College (his architectural diploma is from Sydney).

Smith's studies extended well beyond his architectural diploma, and his certificates and awards include F.R.A.I.A., A.R.I.B.A., Associate of the Royal Sanitary Institute, three town-planning certificates and an O.A.M.

The ambitious town-planning scheme of Northumberland County Council attracted a great deal of local attention at the time, as can be seen here from the large collection of newspaper-cuttings, which are an important source of information. (One needs to be aware, also, that some of the proposals in these plans were not implemented until many years later.)

As well as the town-plans, there are comprehensive documents, and some extensive type-written studies apparently prepared by Smith to complete his full town-planning qualification. Included with this town-planning material, are Smith's detailed lecture-notes from the Vernon Memorial Lectures, The University of Sydney, 1939, from which he gained a certificate. There are also town-planning lecture-notes from the School of Mines, Adelaide, 1946.
