

Adelaide University alumni (including University of Adelaide and University of South Australia alumni) are eligible for a 20% discount on online and in-person short courses.


Adelaide University staff can access a 30% discount for online and in-person short courses.




### In-person short courses

Designed for emerging and mid-level leaders and managers, you'll learn how to become more effective in your role by developing the capability to engage, align and empower staff, set and achieve operational goals, and raise capability from an operational focus to an executive and strategic perspective.

You'll complete this six-month program equipped to work with increasing complexity, change, shifting priorities and resource constraints.

## Program structure

The Leadership and Management Essentials Program is comprised of six 2-day courses delivered over six months at Adelaide University's North Terrace Campus.
