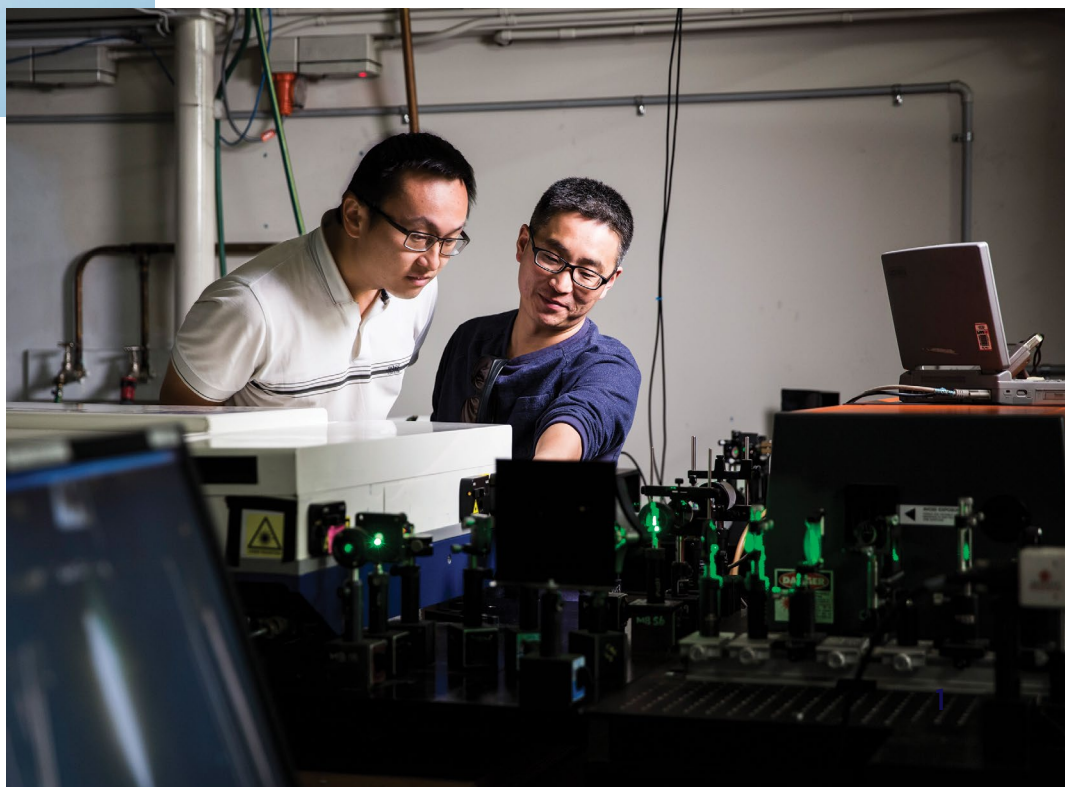

# How to apply

## Step 1

### Explore your study options

Researching your study options is an important first step, and there are many different tools and resources available to help you. You can start by reading through this brochure or go online to explore our postgraduate offerings on our website.

## Step 2

### Check you meet the eligibility and entry requirements

All degrees have entry requirements—these are specific criteria you have to meet in order to be eligible for entry into a degree. Each degree will have different entry requirements, so it's important to find out what these are for your chosen degree and make sure you can meet them.

## Step 3

### Apply

Applications open in early August for study commencing in the following year. You can apply for your chosen degree via the SATAC website, or in some instances direct to Adelaide University. Check the program page to clarify.

Before you apply, it's a good idea to familiarise yourself with the application process. This includes things like key dates and deadlines for applications, as well as SATAC fees and charges and when to pay.

### Apply for 100% online

If applying for a 100% online program you apply directly to Adelaide University and not via SATAC. Your studies will commence in 2026.

## HECS Higher Education Loan

A HECS-HELP or FEE-HELP loan allows students to borrow from the Australian Government to cover some or all of their student contribution.

- To be eligible for HECS-HELP, you must be studying in a Commonwealth Supported Place.
- To be eligible for either HECS-HELP or FEE-HELP you must be an Australian citizen.

FEE-HELP is for students that are studying full-time paying programs. HECS-HELP and/or FEE-HELP will be a debt recorded for them with the Australian Taxation Office (ATO). Students then become responsible for repaying this debt later through the Australian taxation system.
