Description
SA Pathology will fund two scholarships to students in the fourth year of the Bachelor of Laboratory Medicine (Honours). These scholarships aim to improve attraction and retention rates of Medical Scientists in diagnostic pathology laboratories across regional South Australia.

\$2,500 one-off payment
Eligibility and Selection Criteria
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Available to full-time students in the fourth year of the Bachelor of Laboratory Medicine (Honours) who are not currently in receipt of another scholarship. • Applicants must be undertaking the Clinical Practice component of the program. • Scholarships are available only to Australian citizens or Australian permanent residents. • Applicants must submit: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A completed scholarship application form (available online); • A one-page written statement outlining how they would benefit professionally from receiving a scholarship; • Two referees reports; and • Evidence of academic merit. • Completed applications to be submitted to Team Lead – Academic and Program Services, College of Health, email: chs-teachinglearning@unisa.edu.au • Applicants will be invited to attend an interview with the selection panel, which will assess: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Demonstrated communication skills; • Vision for a career in Laboratory Medicine; • A commitment to professional involvement; and • Capacity to act in an ambassadorial role in furthering the program. • Scholarship recipients will be required to undertake a 12-month appointment in a regional SA Pathology laboratory upon completion of their degree, as negotiated with the Head, Regional Services (SA Pathology). • No scholarship will be awarded if there are no suitable applicants.
