## ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

The Academic Scholarships for Year 10 and Year 11 are for new students entering Year 10 and Year 11 in 2027.

These scholarships are awarded to students entirely on the excellence of their results in the Scholarship Selection Test (SST) by the Australian Council for Education Research (ACER).

Each recipient will be expected to provide feedback to the Principal about the impact of the scholarship. The family will be invited to participate in occasional events and activities that recognise and give thanks to the community of donors.

#### **HOW TO APPLY**

Students applying for an Academic Scholarship must sit the ACER exam in May. Results will be distributed to parents at end of June. Whether a scholarship is offered or not, all students will have the opportunity to proceed to the interview stage to discuss future enrolment.

# ALL-ROUNDER SCHOLARSHIP

All-Rounder Scholarship are limited in number for Years 10, 11 or 12 entry in 2027 and are available for new and current students. These scholarships are available to students who demonstrate the ability to significantly contribute to University Senior College in a range of areas.

All-Rounder Scholarship applicants are required to submit documentation indicating ability in a minimum of three of the following areas:

• Academic

- Leadership
- STEM

- Public Speaking
- Sport
- Performing Arts
- Social Justice

As part of the application process, all candidates will have an interview with the Principal or the Dean of Student Experience. All new students who submit a scholarship application are also required to sit a general ability test prior to the interview.
